- (a) with the implementation, monitoring and evaluation of the School Fruit Scheme(SFS) established by Regulation (EC) No 1234/2007 ⁽²⁾, as amended by Council Regulation (EC) No 13/2009 ⁽³⁾, by providing it with expert advice;
- (b) with the elaboration of the report referred to in Article 184(5) of Regulation (EC) No 1234/2007.

The Commission may consult the group on any matter relating to the application of the SFS.

The Commission is therefore calling for applications with a view to appointing the members of the group and establishing the relevant pool list.

2. Features of the group**2.1. Composition**

The group should be composed of scientists and other experts with competences related to the implementation, monitoring and evaluation of the SFS and should deliver independent, excellent and transparent technical advice to the Commission.

It shall consist of 10 members appointed by the Commission from specialists with expertise in nutrition, epidemiology, public health and health promotion, monitoring and evaluation of the SFS, with a suitable background, who have responded to the present call for applications and have been selected accordingly.

The pool list can be used to appoint replacements for members of the group.

2.2. Term of the appointment

Members of the group are appointed for a three-year renewable term of office and may not serve for more than three consecutive mandates. They shall remain in office until such time as they are replaced in accordance with article 4(6) of Decision 2009/986/EU or their term of office ends.

The composition of the group and of the pool list may be reviewed every three years.

2.3. Independence and confidentiality
